

**CITY OF SIOUX FALLS GOLF COURSES
2012 SEASON PASS INFORMATION**

100 ROUND LIMIT

Season passes allow players to play one hundred (100) 18 hole rounds. 9 hole rounds count as 1/2 rounds. Over one hundred (100) rounds before October 1, players pay 50% of the appropriate daily fee. Rounds after October 1 do not count toward the one hundred round limit.

COUPLE PASSES

Couple passes allow for two hundred (200) 18 hole rounds. 9 hole rounds count as 1/2 rounds. Couple passes also include use by children under the age of 18. Eligible youths must have a separate pass number and are subject to the same restrictions as Youth Pass 2. Rounds played by youths count toward the 200 round limit. Over 200 rounds before October 1, players pay 50% of the appropriate daily fee. Rounds after October 1 do not count toward the two hundred round limit.

WEEKDAY PASSES

Weekday passes exclude play on weekends and the following holidays: Monday, May 28, Wednesday, July 4 and Monday, September 3.

EAST 9 / KUEHN PARK PASSES

The East 9 / Kuehn Park season pass is not valid on the 18 hole course at Elmwood.

AGE DEFINITIONS FOR SENIOR, YOUNG ADULT AND JUNIOR PASSES

Seniors must be 65 years of age before August 1, 2012.

Young Adults must be under 25 years of age on April 1, 2012

Juniors must be under 18 years of age on April 1, 2012 or a 2012 high school graduate.

Super seniors must be at least 85 years of age before August 1, 2012.

REGISTERING FOR PLAY

Passholders must present their pass card whenever registering for play at any of the courses. You will not be allowed to play without your pass card. Transfer of your pass card to another golfer is not allowed and will result in forfeiture of playing privileges. You may occasionally be asked to provide a picture I.D. with your card when registering for play.

COURSE RULES AND REGULATIONS

Passholders agree to abide by the rules and regulations of the golf courses, including but not limited to the following:

- Pace of play requirements.
- Registration procedures.
- Tee time procedures.
- Golf course etiquette, replacing divots, repairing ball marks, and raking traps.
- Golf car regulations.
- Responsible use of alcohol by adults.
- Food and beverages must be purchased at the golf course.

**ELMWOOD / KUEHN PARK / PRAIRIE GREEN
2012 SEASON PASS REGULATIONS**

- *** You **MUST** present your pass card when registering for play at any of the golf courses. You may be denied access to the course if you do not have your pass card.
- *** If you lose your card, report it immediately and a new card with a new pass number will be issued.
- *** Passholders are expected to follow all course rules and regulations, including pace of play requirements and tee time procedures.

*** **REFUND POLICY - SEASON PASSES**

MAXIMUM REFUNDS AVAILABLE:

BEFORE THE COURSE OPENS---	100%
OPENING DAY – 4/30/2012-----	75%
5/1/2012-5/31/2012-----	50%
6/1/2012-6/30/2012-----	25%

*** **no refunds after 6/30/2012** ***

*** **All refunds and exchanges pay a \$25 fee** ***

Your refund may be less based on how much you have used your pass. We will calculate your usage based on regular daily fees and subtract that amount from the price of your pass. If this amount is less than the appropriate amount in the table above, you will receive the smaller of the two amounts.

As an example, an Adult All-Time passholder at Elmwood applies for a refund on June 15th having played twenty 18 hole rounds and ten 9 hole rounds. We would compute the refund as follows:

$\$725.00 * 25\% = \181.25	or	$20 \text{ rds} * \$25.00 = \$ 500.00$
		$10 \text{ rds} * \$16.00 = \$ 160.00$
		TOTAL USED = \$ 660.00
		Price of Pass \$ 725.00
		Unused part of pass = \$ 65.00

This person would receive a \$65.00 refund. If the unused part of his pass was greater than \$181.25, he would receive the standard percentage refund of \$181.25. In either case, the \$25 refund/exchange fee would be deducted from the amount.
